Block Djiffere Update

CAP Energy would like to announce that a lien has been granted by the Senegalese courts on the assets of FAR Limited ("FAR") in Senegal, namely its stake in the offshore Rufisque-Sangomar-Sangomar Deep blocks. The lien has been granted as a result of the non-delivery of 3D seismic data over block Djiffere by FAR to which CAP Energy believes TAOL Djiffere Ltd, holder of the Djiffere licence in Senegal, is contractually entitled. CAP Energy is claiming damages of USD\$15 million.

Two court hearings took place in Senegal on 28 August 2017 and on 15 September 2017 in respect of the above in the presence of FAR's representative, Maitre Ibrahima Mbengue.
